HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The School Grants Act Amendment Act, 1939."
- 2. The School Grants Act, being chapter 53 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 27 by inserting therein immediately after the words "whether organized according to law or not" the following words: "or to any person or persons residing in unorganized territory and providing for the education of their children upon such terms and conditions as are approved by the Minister."
- $\ensuremath{\mathbf{3.}}$ This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
