# A BILL TO AMEND THE VEHICLES AND HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT.

#### NOTE.

This Bill makes a number of amendments to The Vehicles and Highway Traffic Act, 1924.

Section 2a is amended so as to permit the driving of a motor vehicle brought into the Province under section 8 by a person who is not the holder of an Alberta driving license provided he is permitted by the law of the country of which he is a resident to drive a motor vehicle on a highway in that country.

Section 11 is amended to permit the cancellation of any license or permit issued under the Act for any violation of any of the provisions of *The Fuel Oil Licensing Act*.

Section 47a is amended and provides that a vehicle about to enter a main Provincial highway shall be brought to a standstill at a point not less than ten feet nor more than fifty feet from the main highway.

An Act to Amend The Vehicles and Highway Traffic Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Vehicles and Highway Traffic Act, 1924, Amendment Act, 1939."
- 2. The Vehicles and Highway Traffic Act, 1924, being chapter 31 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1924, is hereby amended as to section 2a by striking out subsection (1) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:
- "2a.—(1) No person shall drive a motor vehicle on any highway at any time during which he is not the holder of a subsisting chauffeur's license or driver's license issued pursuant to this Act, save and except only in the case of any automobile registered pursuant to section 8 any person driving the same during the period referred to in section 8 who is the owner of the same or any other person driving the same with the consent express or implied of the owner, if such person is permitted by the law of the country of which he is a resident to drive an automobile on a highway in that country."
- 3. The said Act is further amended as to section 11 by striking out the words "or of the *Criminal Code*", where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "or of *The Fuel Oil Licensing Act* or of any regulations made thereunder, or of the *Criminal Code*".
- 4. The said Act is further amended as to section 47a by striking out the same and by substituting therefor the following:
- "47a. Every person who is in charge of any vehicle or animal upon any highway which leads into a main Provincial highway shall before entering upon such main highway bring such vehicle or animal to a standstill at a point not less than ten feet nor more than fifty feet from such main highway and shall not cause such vehicle or animal to enter upon such main highway either for the

purpose of crossing the same or proceeding along the same, until the traffic conditions upon such main highway are such that the vehicle or animal may enter upon such highway with safety."

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
