An Act Respecting Charges on Grain Delivered to
Elevators.

(Assented to _____, 1939.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Grain Charges Limita-
tion Act.*"

2.—(1) On, from and after the coming into force of this
Act, upon the delivery to an elevator licensed under *The
Canada Grain Act*, of any grain grown in the Province
which is so delivered by or on behalf of the grower thereof,
every charge upon such grain whether created by contract,
statute or otherwise subsisting at the time of such delivery
save and except charges to secure the payment of money
owing to the Government of the Province or the Govern-
ment of Canada or to any municipal district or to any
school district of which notice has been duly given
previously to the delivery of the grain subject to the charge,
shall cease and determine and shall thereafter be void and
of no effect.

(2) For the purposes of this section "charge" means
every charge, lien and encumbrance of every kind and des-
cription upon any cereal grain whether created by contract,
statute or otherwise and whether so created before or after
the coming into force of this Act.

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which
it is assented to.
