- HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:
- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Guarantees Acknowledgment Act Amendment Act, 1940."
- 2. The Guarantees Acknowledgment Act, being chapter 74 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1939, is hereby amended by inserting therein immediately after section 4 the following new section:
- "4a. This Act shall not apply to any guarantee hereafter executed when the obligation incurred under such guarantee is to a bank incorporated under the provisions of *The Bank Act* and does not exceed the sum of five hundred dollars."
- $\mbox{\bf 3.}$ This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
