HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Lloydminster Municipal Amalgamation Act, 1930, Amendment Act, 1941."

2. The Lloydminster Municipal Amalgamation Act, 1930, being chapter 54 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1930, is hereby amended as to section 13 by striking out the words "supplementary revenue tax", where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "social services tax".

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
