HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Pharmaceutical Association Act Amendment Act, 1941."
- 2. The Pharmaceutical Association Act, being chapter 203 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 29 by striking out the last word in subsection (1) thereof and by substituting therefor the following word: "para-amino-benzene-sulphonamide"
- $\ensuremath{\mathbf{3.}}$ This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
