HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Alberta Municipal Assessment Commission Act Amendment Act, 1941."
- 2. The Alberta Municipal Assessment Commission Act, being chapter 63 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1935, is hereby amended as to section 28 by striking out the words "town or village", where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "town, village or municipal district".
- $\ensuremath{\mathbf{3.}}$ This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
