HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Tuberculosis Act Amendment Act, 1941."

2. The Tuberculosis Act, being chapter 50 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1936, is hereby amended as to section 4 by striking out the same and by substituting therefor the following:

"4. Persons who have been residents of the Province for twelve successive months out of the twenty-four months immediately preceding admission into any Sanatorium operated by the Minister under this Act, and who are not residing on Dominion Government lands, shall not be required to pay any fee or charge for hospitalization or treatment in any such Sanatorium, and any other persons shall be liable to the payment of such amounts for hospitalization and treatment, or either of them, as may be from time to time prescribed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
