An Act to amend The Vital Statistics Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Vital Statistics Act Amendment Act, 1941."
- 2. The Vital Statistics Act, being chapter 24 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 36 by striking out the same and by substituting therefor the following:
- "36. Every birth, marriage or death registered by the authority of the Registrar General as herein provided, after the expiration of one year and before the expiration of four years from the birth, marriage or death, as the case may be, shall be accompanied by a search fee of one dollar and a registration fee of one dollar, and any such birth, marriage or death registered after the expiration of the said period of fours years, shall be accompanied by a search fee of one dollar and a registration fee of two dollars."
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
