An Act for the Further Continuation in Force of The Banking Corporations Temporary Additional Taxation Act, 1938.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Banking Corporations Temporary Additional Taxation Act Continuation Act, 1941."
- 2. The Banking Corporations Temporary Additional Taxation Act, being chapter 8 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1938, is hereby amended as to section 2 by striking out the words and figures "the years 1938, 1939, 1940 and 1941" and by substituting therefor the words and figures "the years 1938, 1939, 1940, 1941 and 1942".
- 3. This  $\operatorname{Act}$  shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
