A BILL RESPECTING SUPERANNUATION AND RE-
TIRING ALLOWANCES FOR EMPLOYEES OF
THE ALBERTA LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD

NOTE.

This Bill enables the Liquor Control Board to set up a scheme to provide pensions and other benefits for its employees. These employees do not come under *The Superannuation Act* and the intention of the Act is to provide a similar scheme under which the Board and its employees will both contribute to a fund which will provide above benefits.

An Act respecting Superannuation and Retiring Allowances
for Employees of The Alberta Liquor Control Board

(Assented to , 1941.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Alberta Liquor Control Board Superannuation Act.*"

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,—

- (a) "Board" means the Alberta Liquor Control Board;
- (b) "Committee" means the Committee appointed to administer the scheme;
- (c) "Minister" means the member of the Executive Council under whose direction *The Government Liquor Control Act* of Alberta is from time to time administered;
- (d) "Scheme" means the plan, as amended from time to time, under which Superannuation and Retiring Allowances and Death Benefits are to be paid.

3. The Board shall have power to provide for annuities or other payments to employees or dependants of employees of the Board by way of pension, superannuation, retiring allowances, allowances on account of illness, death benefits or any other similar benefit, and in the event of so doing shall embody the provision so made in a scheme which upon being approved of by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, shall be operative according to its tenor.

4. The scheme shall be administered by a Committee to be known as "The Alberta Liquor Control Board Superannuation Fund Committee," which shall consist of three members:

- (a) One appointed by the Board, who shall be Chairman of the Committee; and
- (b) Two to be elected by popular ballot of all participating employees.

5. The Alberta Liquor Control Board shall make an annual payment out of the revenue of the Board into the

fund, which may be created under the scheme aforesaid, of such sum of money as may be required under the provisions of the said scheme:

Provided, however, that any sum of money paid by the Board with respect to contributory pensions or annuities shall not in any year exceed the sum contributed for that year by the said employees, for the provision of annuities or other payments by way of pension or superannuation benefit.

6. The said scheme may be amended from time to time by the Lieutenant Governor in Council upon the recommendation of the said Minister.

7. The interest of any employee in the fund under this Act and in any annuity granted under the provisions of this Act shall not be subject to garnishment or attachment or seizure or any legal process, except in respect of failure to account for public moneys, and shall be unassignable.

8. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
