A BILL TO AMEND THE OFFICIAL GUARDIAN ACT

NOTE.

This Bill amends The Official Guardian Act.

Under the existing section 6, notice of every application made to a court in respect of infants, missing persons or convicts has to be served on the official guardian. This official is interested only in the property or the estate of such persons, and this amendment is designed to do away with the necessity of serving him with notice of applications other than those dealing with the property or the estate of such persons.

An Act to amend The Official Guardian Act.

(Assented to , 1941.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Official Guardian Act Amendment Act, 1941."

2. The Official Guardian Act, being chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 4 by adding thereto immediately after the words "The Children's Protection Act", where the same occur in paragraph (e) thereof, the following words: "or a ward of the Province as defined by The Child Welfare Act".

3. The said Act is further amended as to section 6 by striking out the words "in respect of an infant, missing person or convict, or of the estate of any such person," where the same occur in subsection (1) thereof, and by substituting therefor the words "in respect of the property or estate of an infant, missing person or convict".

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
