HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Tax and Rate Collection Act Amendment Act, 1941."
- 2. The Tax and Rate Collection Act, being chapter 46 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929, is hereby amended as to section 6b by adding at the end of subsection (2) thereof the following proviso:

"Provided, however, that in addition to having the foregoing qualifications an elector must be a British subject."

 ${\bf 3.}$ This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
