An Act to amend The Corporations Taxation Act.

(Assented to _____, 1941.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Corporations Taxation Act Amendment Act, 1941.*"

2. *The Corporations Taxation Act*, being chapter 29 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 17*a* by striking out the words "or the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars, whichever amount is the greater" where the same occur in subsection (1) thereof.

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
