A BILL TO AMEND THE NEW WEST I.D.
COLONIZATION ACT

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The New West I.D. Colonization Act*.

The purpose of the amendments made by this Bill by striking out sections 6, 9 and 11 is to limit the obligation of the Provincial Treasurer to paying water service charges and only out of moneys appropriated by the Legislature.

The amendment to section 18 is to enable the manager to borrow from either a chartered bank or treasury branch.

An Act to amend The New West I.D. Colonization Act.

(Assented to _____, 1941.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited at "*The New West I.D. Colonization Act Amendment Act, 1941.*"

2. *The New West I.D. Colonization Act*, being chapter 72 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1931, is hereby amended as to section 6 by striking out the same.

3. The said Act is further amended as to section 9 by striking out the same and by substituting therefor the following:

"**9.** Upon the vesting of any land in the manager or upon the making of any agreement for the extinguishment of water right payments imposed upon any lands under the provisions of *The Irrigation Districts Act*, the Provincial Treasurer shall pay out of moneys appropriated for the purpose by the Legislature such sum or sums as is or are required to discharge the water service charges imposed upon the said lands under the provisions of *The Irrigation Districts Act.*"

4. The said Act is further amended as to section 11 by striking out the words "otherwise than by the Provincial Treasurer" where the same occur in subsection (3) thereof.

5. The said Act is further amended as to section 18 by inserting in subsection (3) thereof after the words "chartered bank", where the same occur therein, the words "or treasury branch".

6. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
