A BILL RESPECTING AGREEMENTS FOR SALE OF MECHANIZED ROAD BUILDING EQUIPMENT

NOTE.

The object of this Bill is to require persons who sell to municipalities and others mechanized road building equipment to keep in the Province repair parts so that they may be quickly available when required. At present the municipalities have difficulty in getting repair parts for such machinery. The Bill follows closely the terms of section 5 of chapter 152 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, The Farm Machinery Act.

An Act Respecting Agreements for Sale of Mechanized Road Building Equipment.

(Assented to

, 1941.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Road Building Machinery Equipment Act."
- 2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any contract or agreement there shall be implied in any contract or agreement for sale to any person or corporation in Alberta of mechanized road building equipment (whether the agreement be written or oral and whether for a sale for cash or by instalments) a warranty to the effect that all repair parts in adequate quantities for the said machinery are kept by the vendor in the Province and will be so kept for a period of ten years from the date of the said agreement or from the date of sale, if such sale is for cash, and may be obtained at the place of business of that agent of the vendor who is nearest to the purchaser or at some other well advertised point in the Province;

Provided that the keeping by the manufacturers or general provincial distributors thereof of a stock of the necessary repair parts as aforesaid on hand at two places of business at least two hundred miles apart in the Province shall be deemed to be compliance by a vendor with the terms of the implied contract of warranty set out in this section.

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
