A BILL TO AMEND THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS ACT, 1929.

NOTE.

This Bill amends The Public Highways Act, 1929.

At present there are conflicting provisions in this Act, The Public Service Vehicles Act, and The Vehicles and Highway Traffic Act dealing with the closing of parts of highways by Ministerial order or by regulation. To avoid confusion these provisions are being struck out of this Act and The Vehicles and Highway Traffic Act, and the power is being given to the Highway Traffic Board on the request of the Minister of Public Works under The Public Service Vehicles Act. The Minister of Public Works may still act through that Board to close any part of a highway and has essentially the same powers as given him by section 25.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Public Highways Act, 1929, Amendment Act, 1941."
- 2. The Public Highways Act, 1929, being chapter 53 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929, is hereby amended as to section 25 by striking out the same.
- $\ensuremath{\mathbf{3.}}$ This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
