An Act to amend The Crown Cultivation Leases Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Crown Cultivation Leases Act Amendment Act, 1941."
- 2. The Crown Cultivation Leases Act, being chapter 49 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1937, is hereby amended as to section 3 by striking out the same and by substituting therefor the following:
- "3. The Minister of Lands and Mines is hereby authorized and empowered to pay one-fourth part of the money received by him on account of the share of crop from any land held as aforesaid to the municipal district or improvement district in which such land is situate, and one-fourth part of such money to the school district in which the land is situate, or in case such school district is in a school division, to such school division."
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
