

# BILL

No. 2 of 1942.

An Act to amend the Act Incorporating the Western Union Insurance Company.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1942.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Act to Incorporate the Western Union Insurance Company, being chapter 34 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1940, is hereby amended by striking out section 3 and substituting the following:

“**3.** The capital of the company shall be five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00), divided into 5,000 shares of the par value of \$100.00 each, which may be increased to one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) by a resolution of the directors sanctioned by a special resolution of the company as defined by *The Companies Act*, and by filing with the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies a copy of the resolution accompanied by such fees as would be required for a like increase in the capital of a company under *The Companies Act*.”

**2.** The said Act is further amended as to section 7 (*d*) by adding after the word “Bond” the word “Fidelity”.

**3.** The said Act is further amended as to section 8 by striking out the figures and words “sections 56 to 61, both inclusive”, and inserting the following: “sections 40, 41, 58 to 62 inclusive, and sections 83, 84, 85 and 86”.

**4.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
