### Bill No. 32 of 1942.

#### A BILL TO AMEND THE SPECIAL AREAS ACT, 1939.

#### NOTE.

This Bill amends The Special Areas Act, 1939, by making special provisions with regard to advertising sales under The Tax Recovery Act, 1938. The latter Act requires an advertisement of a public auction containing a description of all the parcels to be put up for sale. The amendment provides that in special areas the parcels need not be described in the advertisement but that a list may be inspected at the office of each special area. The present method is expensive and the Special Areas Board recommends the change so as to cut down expenses and state that the circulation of the local paper reaches a small percentage of the people in the areas. The other requirements such as advertising in The Alberta Gazette are not changed in any way by the amendment.

# BILL

#### No. 32 of 1942.

An Act to amend The Special Areas Act, 1939.

#### (Assented to , 1942.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Special Areas Act, 1939, Amendment Act, 1942."

2. The Special Areas Act, 1939, being chapter 34 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1939, is hereby amended by adding immediately after section 29, the following new section:

Immediately after section 29, the following new section: **29a.** The provisions of sections 11 and 12 of *The Tax Recovery Act*, 1938, in so far as they relate to the advertisement of a public auction in a newspaper, shall be deemed to be sufficiently complied with if a notice is inserted in one issue of a newspaper having general circulation in the area published not less than ten days and not more than twenty days before the date of the sale, stating the place and date of the sale and the hour at which the auction shall commence and that a list of the lands to be offered for sale may be inspected at the office of the Board of the Special Area, and specifying where that office is situated."

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
