This Bill repeals *The Farm Cultivation Lien Act*.

The provisions of this Act have not been used to any very great extent, and it is deemed advisable to repeal it. Apparently there is little need for the special rights granted thereby, and contractors will, of course, still have their ordinary legal remedies for recovery of moneys owing to them.

# BILL

An Act to repeal The Farm Cultivation Lien Act.

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Farm Cultivation Lien Act Repeal Act*."
- 2.** *The Farm Cultivation Lien Act*, being chapter 45 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1938, is hereby repealed.
- 3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
