A BILL TO REPEAL THE THRESHER EMPLOYEES'
LIEN ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill repeals *The Thresher Employees' Lien Act*.

The special rights and privileges granted by this Act are not used to any appreciable extent. It is deemed advisable that the Act should be repealed. Thresher employees would still have recourse to the ordinary remedies provided by law for recovery of their wages.

An Act to repeal The Thresher Employees' Lien Act.

(Assented to _____, 1942.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Thresher Employees' Lien Act Repeal Act.*"
- 2.** *The Thresher Employees' Lien Act*, being chapter 184 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby repealed.
- 3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
