A BILL TO AMEND THE SCHOOL ASSESSMENT ACT.

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NOTE.

This proposed amendment to *The School Assessment Act* authorizes a rebate on school taxes sixty days from the date of mailing tax notice. Certain school districts send out their tax notices in the middle of the summer which prevents ratepayers getting the discounts authorized by section 39a on payments made before the first of June. The object of the amendment is to extend the privilege to these ratepayers of a rebate in such cases. The amendment brings *The School Assessment Act* into line with the provisions of *The Municipal District Act*.

# BILL

No. 43 of 1942.

An Act to amend The School Assessment Act, 1931.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1942.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The School Assessment Act, 1931, Amendment Act, 1942.*"

**2.** *The School Assessment Act*, being chapter 33 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1931, is hereby amended by inserting immediately after section 39*a* the following new section:

"**39*b*.** The Board may, by resolution, allow a rebate at a rate not exceeding ten per cent upon all current taxes paid within a period which shall not exceed sixty days after the date of mailing of the tax notice."

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
