

Bill No. 10 of 1943.

A BILL TO AMEND THE TELEPHONE AND
TELEGRAPH ACT.

NOTE.

The only change made by the Bill in section 10 of the Act is to extend the benefits authorized by the scheme to death benefits payable to the dependants or estates of the deceased.

The proviso to section 12 struck out by the Bill limited the contributions by the telephone system to the pension fund to not more than the amounts contributed by the employees. The amendment, by striking out this proviso, removes this limit.

An Act to amend The Telephone and Telegraph Act.

(Assented to _____, 1943.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Telephone and Telegraph Act*, being chapter 198 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 10 thereof by striking out the same and substituting therefor the following:

“**10.** The Minister of Railways and Telephones shall have power to provide for annuities or other payments by way of pension, superannuation or death benefit to the employees or any class or classes of employees, their dependants or their executors or administrators, as the case may be, and in the event of so doing shall embody the provision so made in a scheme which, upon being approved by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, shall be operative according to its tenor.”

2. The said Act is further amended as to section 12 thereof by striking out the proviso to the said section.

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
