

Bill No. 28 of 1943.

A BILL TO AMEND THE PUBLIC SERVICE
EFFICIENCY ACT.

NOTE.

Section 1 of the Bill amends section 3 of the Act to divide the Public Service into two main divisions, Division 1 corresponding to Class 1 of the old Act and Division 2 consisting of employees not included in Division 1. Division 2 shall be subdivided into such classes and grades as may be decided upon from time to time by order in council upon the recommendation and report of the Civil Service Commissioner. This will provide more flexibility in the grading and classification of the civil service.

Sections 2 and 3 of the Bill amend sections 5 and 6 of the Act to make the appropriate changes to correspond with the change made in section 3 thereof.

An Act to amend The Public Service Efficiency Act.

(Assented to _____, 1943.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Public Service Efficiency Act*, being chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended by striking out section 3 thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

“**3.**—(1) The Public Service shall be divided into two main divisions as follows:

“(a) Division 1 shall consist of the following employees: Deputy Ministers, Clerks of the Legislative Assembly, Legislative Counsel, Clerk of the Executive Council, Provincial Auditor, members of the Board of Public Utility Commissioners, the Provincial Board of Health, members of the Workmen’s Compensation Board, members of the Alberta Liquor Control Board and the Civil Service Commissioner;

“(b) Division 2 shall consist of employees not included in Division 1.

“(2) The employees of the Public Service included in Division 2 shall be subdivided into such classes and grades as may be decided upon from time to time by Order in Council upon the recommendation of the President of the Council on the report of the Civil Service Commissioner.

“(3) Any employee may be transferred from one class of Division 2 to another upon the recommendation of the President of the Council on the report of the Civil Service Commissioner.”

2. The said Act is further amended as to section 5 by striking out paragraph (c) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

“(c) to report with regard to the grading, classification and scale of salaries in schedule form for Division 2 which schedule shall also provide for fixed increases in salary until the maximum amount is reached, and for promotions.”

3. The said Act is further amended by striking out section 6 thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

“6. No person shall be appointed to any office, clerkship or other position in Division 2 of the Public Service save upon the recommendation of the President of the Council nor until the Civil Service Commissioner has certified in writing that the person to be appointed is duly qualified for that position.”

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
