# A BILL TO AMEND THE VEHICLES AND HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT.

#### NOTE.

The new subsection to section 20, enacted by section 1 of the Bill, authorizes the Minister to grant temporary permits to persons between the ages of sixteen and eighteen years to operate a motor vehicle as a chauffeur. The subsection, however, does not authorize the granting of permits to such persons to drive a vehicle used for the purpose of transporting passengers for hire.

### BILL

An Act to amend The Vehicles and Highway Traffic Act.

, 1943.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Vehicles and Highway Traffic Act, being chapter 275 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 20 by adding immediately after subsection (1) thereof the following new subsection:
- "(1a) The Minister may, after careful consideration of the qualifications of any person between the ages of sixteen and eighteen years, who holds a driver's certificate, grant to him a temporary permit for the operating of a motor vehicle as a chauffeur, providing that such motor vehicle is not being used for the purpose of transporting passengers for hire."
- 2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
