A BILL TO AMEND THE VEHICLES AND  
HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT.

NOTE.

The new subsection to section 20, enacted by section 1 of the Bill, authorizes the Minister to grant temporary permits to persons between the ages of sixteen and eighteen years to operate a motor vehicle as a chauffeur. The subsection, however, does not authorize the granting of permits to such persons to drive a vehicle used for the purpose of transporting passengers for hire.

# BILL

No. 42 of 1943.

An Act to amend The Vehicles and Highway Traffic Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1943.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** *The Vehicles and Highway Traffic Act*, being chapter 275 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 20 by adding immediately after subsection (1) thereof the following new subsection:

“(1a) The Minister may, after careful consideration of the qualifications of any person between the ages of sixteen and eighteen years, who holds a driver’s certificate, grant to him a temporary permit for the operating of a motor vehicle as a chauffeur, providing that such motor vehicle is not being used for the purpose of transporting passengers for hire.”

**2.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
