A BILL TO AMEND THE MOTHERS' ALLOWANCE ACT.

NOTE.

The amendment to section 4 of the Act made by section 1 of the Bill authorizes the payment of allowance with respect to any children under sixteen. The provision now applies to boys under fifteen and girls under sixteen.

The new section 7a enacted by section 2 of the Bill permits the extension of payments in proper cases, for the balance of the school academic year where a child becomes sixteen after the opening of school in the December term while attending school and making satisfactory progress.

The amendment to section 13 merely cures an omission in the Act.

An Act to amend The Mothers' Allowance Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Mothers' Allowance Act, being chapter 302 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 4 by striking out the words "having in her custody a child or children under the age of fifteen years in the case of boys and sixteen years in the case of girls", and by substituting therefor the words "having in her custody a child or children under the age of sixteen years".
- 2. The said Act is further amended by adding immediately after section 7 the following new section:
- "7a. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Act, if a child with respect to whom payments are being made under this Act reaches the age of sixteen subsequent to the date of the opening of school in the December term, and is then attending school and making satisfactory progress, the Minister may continue payments to the end of the June term."
- **3.** The said Act is further amended as to section 13 by adding immediately after the word "committal", where the same occurs in the second line thereof, the words "or of his desertion of his wife".
- 4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
