An Act to amend The Limitation of Actions Act.

(Assented to _____, 1943.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advise and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Limitation of Actions Act*, being chapter 133 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new section:

“**53.** Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or in any other Act in force in the Province limiting or prescribing the time within which actions or other proceedings are to be commenced, any action or other proceeding the commencement of which is or was prohibited by the provisions of *The Debt Adjustment Act, 1931*, and amendments thereto; *The Debt Adjustment Act, 1933*, and amendments thereto; *The Debt Adjustment Act, 1936*, and amendments thereto; or which would have been prohibited by *The Debt Adjustment Act, 1937*, and amendments thereto, if the said Act had been within the legislative powers of the Legislature of the Province, may be commenced within one year from the date upon which this Act comes into force:

“Provided, however, that this section shall not apply to any actions or other proceedings which apart from the provisions of this section might be commenced more than one year from the date upon which this Act comes into force.”

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
