A BILL TO AMEND THE TREASURY DEPARTMENT ACT.

NOTE.

Section 1 of the Bill is self-explanatory.

Section 2 of the Bill enables the Lieutenant Governor in Council to appoint an auditor at a salary not exceeding \$6,500.00. As the Act now stands a salary of \$6,500.00 must be paid to the Provincial Auditor and it is desirable that the Lieutenant Governor in Council should have power to appoint a new auditor at a lesser salary.

An Act to amend The Treasury Department Act.

(Assented to _____, 1943.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advise and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Treasury Department Act*, being chapter 18 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended by adding immediately after section 4 thereof the following new section:

“**4a.** The Lieutenant Governor in Council may from time to time, upon the recommendation of the Provincial Treasurer, make such changes in the internal organization of the Department as may be considered necessary as a result of changing circumstances and conditions.”

2. The said Act is further amended as to section 63 thereof by inserting immediately after the word “of”, where the same occurs in line one of subsection (2), the words “not more than”.

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
