An Act to amend the Medicine Hat City Charter.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented by certain citizens of the City of Medicine Hat for an amendment of the Acts constituting *The Medicine Hat Charter*;

Whereas it is reasonable that the prayer of the said citizens be granted;

Now therefore His Majesty, by and with the consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

The Medicine Hat Charter, being chapter 68 of the Statutes of Alberta (1906) as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended as follows:

1. As to Title 3, section 4, by striking out the words "a male" where they appear in the third line thereof.

2. As to Title 4, section 5, by adding thereto as subsection (4) the following: "(4) the names of all persons who are British subjects either by birth or naturalization, twenty-one years of age or over, who have resided continuously in the City for six months prior to the 1st day of June immediately preceding the making up of the voters' list."

3. As to Title 3, subsection (4), by striking out of the said section the words "and is at the time of the election the owner of free hold real estate rated in his own name on the last revised assessment roll of the City to at least the value of \$1,000.00" where the same appear at the end of the said Section.

4. This Act shall come into force on the day on which it is assented to.
