A BILL TO PROVIDE FOR THE INSPECTION OF FISH.

NOTE.

This Bill enacts a new Act, the purpose of which is to validate any provisions of the Dominion Act which may be outside the jurisdiction of Parliament and within that of the Province. Similar Acts have been passed in four other Provinces.

BILL

An Act to provide for the Inspection of Fish.

(Assented to , 1944.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE.

1. This Act may be cited as "The Alberta Fish Inspection Act."

2. The provisions of *The Fish Inspection Act* which deal with the inspection of certain pickled, salted and other kinds of fish, enacted by the Parliament of Canada and the amendments heretofore made thereto in so far as any of them are within the legislative competence of this Legislature, shall have the force of law in the Province of Alberta as if enacted by this Legislature, and unless and until otherwise enacted by this Legislature shall remain in full force and effect in this Province.

3.—(1) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may declare any amendments hereafter made to *The Fish Inspection Act* and any order heretofore or hereafter made thereunder in so far as any of them are within the legislative competence of this Legislature, to have the force of law in the Province of Alberta as if enacted by this Legislature, and unless and until otherwise enacted by this Legislature such amendments or order shall remain in full force and effect in this Province.

(2) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may declare any regulations heretofore or hereafter made under *The Fish Inspection Act*, in so far as they are within the legislative competence of this Legislature, to have the force of law in the Province of Alberta as if enacted by this Legislature, but nothing herein contained shall prevent the Lieutenant Governor in Council from exercising his power to rescind, revoke, amend or vary any regulation.

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
