

Bill No. 19 of 1944.

A BILL TO AMEND THE CHANGE OF NAME ACT

NOTE.

Paragraph (c) of section 4 which is struck out by this amendment, reads as follows:

“(c) A certified copy of his naturalization certificate where the applicant is a British subject by naturalization;”.

This is a portion of the material required to be furnished on an application for change of name. It does not provide for the case of persons who under the former provisions of the Naturalization Act became British subjects by virtue of the naturalization of the father. The amendment is to make it possible for such persons to furnish proof of their naturalization.

An Act to amend The Change of Name Act.

(Assented to _____, 1944.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Change of Name Act*, being chapter 328 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 4 thereof by striking out paragraph (c) and by substituting therefor the following:

“(c) A certified copy of the naturalization certificate, by virtue of which the applicant claims to be a British subject by naturalization;”.

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
