

Bill No. 41 of 1944.

A BILL TO AMEND THE SCHOOL ATTENDANCE ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends section 3 of *The School Attendance Act*, chapter 178, R.S.A., 1942. That section provides for compulsory school attendance up to the age of fifteen years. The purpose of the amendment is to require the continuation of the attendance until the end of the June term if the pupil becomes fifteen years of age during that term.

Subsection (8) of section 7 which is amended by section 2 of the Bill, required an attendance officer to report monthly to the school board as well as to the Department. The amendment strikes out the provision requiring the report to the Department, as this is no longer considered necessary.

An Act to amend The School Attendance Act.

(Assented to _____, 1944.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The School Attendance Act*, being chapter 178 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 3 by adding at the end thereof the following additional proviso:

"Provided further, that if a pupil becomes of the full age of fifteen years at any time during the June term, he shall be obliged to continue in attendance at school until the end of that term as though he had not reached the full age of fifteen years."

2. The said Act is further amended as to section 7 by striking out the words "as well as to the Department" where the same occur in subsection (8) thereof.

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
