A BILL TO AMEND THE OPERATION OF SCHOOLS (WAR) ACT.

NOTE.

This Act, which is chapter 6 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1943, provided for the school summer vacation being from the first of August to the day immediately preceding the second Monday in October. The purpose of the amendment is to change the holiday period to the period from the sixteenth day of July to the thirtieth day of September (both inclusive).

An Act to amend The Operation of Schools (War) Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Operation of Schools (War) Act, being chapter 6 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1943, is hereby amended as to section 3 by striking out the words "from the first day of August to the day immediately preceding the second Monday in October," where the same occur in paragraph (b) thereof, and by substituting therefor the words "from the sixteenth day of July to the thirtieth day of September."
- **2.** The said Act is further amended as to section 5 by striking out the words "on the second Monday in October" where the same occur in subsection (2) thereof, and by substituting therefor the words "on the first day of October."
- 3. The said Act is further amended as to section 6 by striking out the words "the period between the tenth day of October and the thirty-first day of July" and by substituting therefor the words "the period between the first day of October and the fifteenth day of July."
- **4.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
