A BILL TO AMEND THE LOCAL TAX ARREARS CONSOLIDATION ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill Amends The Local Tax Arrears Consolidation Act, chapter 163, R.S.A., 1942.

The subsection amended by this Bill provides for a consolidation of taxes in cases where the land has been finally acquired by a municipality. The word "former" is introduced before the word "owner" because at the time of the application for consolidation the actual owner is the municipality.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Local Tax Arrears Consolidation Act, being chapter 163 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 4 by adding immediately before the word "owner," where the same occurs in the third line of subsection (2) thereof, the word "former."
- 2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
