A BILL TO AMEND THE SALE OF CHATTELS BY
PUBLIC AUCTION ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends *The Sale of Chattels by Public Auction Act*, chapter 227, R.S.A., 1942.

The amendment imposes an additional duty on auctioneers, namely, to furnish persons interested in goods sold with an itemized statement within fourteen days after the sale.

An Act to amend The Sale of Chattels by Public Auction Act.

(Assented to _____, 1944.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Sale of Chattels by Public Auction Act*, being chapter 227 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 13 by adding at the end thereof the following new paragraph:

“(e) within fourteen days after an auction sale, deliver to the person for whom the sale has been held and to each person having an interest in or charge upon any goods or chattels sold as disclosed by the statutory declaration or statement required by section 11 to be delivered to the auctioneer, an itemized statement of such goods and chattels and the amounts received therefor.”

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
