A BILL TO AMEND THE ALIMONY ORDERS
ENFORCEMENT ACT.

NOTE.

The amendments made by section 1 of this Bill are necessitated by the incorporation of *The Children of Unmarried Parents Act* in the new Child Welfare Act, and the amendment made by section 2 is to make the maximum term of imprisonment agree with that provided in Part IV of *The Child Welfare Act*.

An Act to amend The Alimony Orders Enforcement Act.

(Assented to _____, 1944.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Alimony Orders Enforcement Act*, being chapter 110 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended as to section 3, subsection (1), and sections 15 and 16 by adding immediately after the words "*The Children of Unmarried Parents Act*", where the same occur therein, the words "Part IV of *The Child Welfare Act*".

2. The said Act is further amended as to section 8 by striking out the words "forty days", where the same occur in subsection (1) thereof, and by substituting therefor the words "one year".

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
