#### **Government Bills and Orders**

On motion by Hon. Mr. Elzinga, Acting Government House Leader, the Assembly resolved itself into Committee of the Whole.

The following Bill was taken under consideration:

Bill 15 Workers' Compensation Amendment Act, 1990 — Hon. Mr. Trynchy

Mr. Gibeault, Hon. Member for Edmonton-Millwoods, moved that the Bill be amended as follows:

Section 7 is amended:

- (a) in section 53.1(1):
  - (i) by striking out the words "may by order" and substituting "shall";
    (ii) by adding "or temporary disability exceeding 12 months," after the words "permanent partial disability";
  - (b) by adding the following after proposed section 53.1(1):

(1.1) "The adjustment shall take place once a year on January 31 and shall be equal to the increase in the Consumer Price Index for the previous calendar year as measured by Statistics Canada.";

A debate followed.
