Members' Statements

Mrs. Sarich, Hon. Member for Edmonton-Decore, made a statement recognizing the 75th anniversary of Canada's first mosque, the Al Rashid Mosque, and the work of the Edmonton chapter of the Canadian Council of Muslim Women.

Mr. Wilson, Hon. Member for Calgary-Shaw, made a statement regarding Betty Anne Gagnon, a developmentally disabled woman who tragically passed away on November 20, 2009, and the Persons with Developmental Disabilities program.

Ms Fenske, Hon. Member for Fort Saskatchewan-Vegreville, made a statement recognizing the 100th anniversary of the Village of Chipman and the successful centennial celebration held this past summer.

Mr. Luan, Hon. Member for Calgary-Hawkwood, made a statement recognizing the community of Arbour Lake in Calgary as being named the best neighborhood in the city in Avenue Magazine's July 2013 edition.

Member for Red Deer-North, presented a petition from 188 Albertans urging the Government to introduce a Bill which will preserve Albertans' 65-year investment in the pheasant rearing, release and hunting of pheasants program such that it maintains and enhances our hunting culture and heritage through the program's support by the Department of Environment and Sustainable Resource Development; Tourism, Parks and Recreation; Agriculture and Rural Development; and Culture and Community Spirit (for a fair share of province-wide lottery profits).
