Mr. Yao, Hon. Member for Fort McMurray-Wood Buffalo, made a statement thanking the many volunteers who selflessly supported evacuees and helped with the firefighting efforts in the Fort McMurray area, including Mrs. Aheer, Hon. Member for Chestermere-Rocky View, who has taken in a Fort McMurray-Wood Buffalo constituency staffer and his friends.
