A debate followed.

Ms Ganley, Hon. Member for Calgary-Mountain View, on behalf of Mr. Bilous, Official Opposition House Leader, moved that the motion be amended by deleting all the words after "that" and substituting the following:

Bill 21, Ensuring Fiscal Sustainability Act, 2019, be not now read a second time but that the subject matter of the Bill be referred to the Standing Committee on Families and Communities in accordance with Standing Order 74.2.

A debate followed on the amendment.
