Bill 24 Alberta Bill of Rights Amendment Act, 2024 — Hon. Mr. Amery

Hon. Mr. Sabir, Hon. Member for Calgary-Bhullar-McCall, moved that the Bill be amended in section 4 by adding the following immediately after clause (b):

(b.1) by adding the following immediately after subsection (1):

(1.1) For the purpose of subsection (1)(a.1), the right to the enjoyment of property includes the right of an individual not to be restricted or prohibited from installing or using a solar energy system that is attached to the individual's property and designed to convert sunlight into electrical energy or solar thermal energy.
