## Guide to the 2012-2014 Speaker Index

Committee mandate: The Standing Committee on Alberta's Economic Future is an all-party committee consisting of 18 Members of the Legislative Assembly. It may meet to review a bill or to consider an issue referred to it by the Assembly and can also meet on its own initiative to consider issues within its mandate. The mandate of the Standing Committee on Alberta's Economic Future relates to the areas of agriculture and rural development; international and intergovernmental relations; enterprise and advanced education; tourism, parks, and recreation; and infrastructure.

There are two indexes for the transcripts of meetings of the Standing Committee on Alberta's Economic Future, a **subject index** and a **speaker index**. Committee activities during the 28th Legislature, First Session (May 23, 2012 – March 2, 2014) were as follows: review of the bitumen royalty in kind program, high-speed rail service review, and 2013-14 main estimates debates for the departments of Agriculture and Rural Development; Enterprise and Advanced Education; Executive Council; Infrastructure; International and Intergovernmental Relations; and Tourism, Parks and Recreation.
