### Guide to the 2023 Speaker Index

**Committee mandate:** The Standing Committee on Families and Communities is a legislative policy committee with a mandate related to the areas of children and family services; education; health; justice; mental health and addiction; public safety and emergency services; seniors, community, and social services; and Service Alberta and red tape reduction.

On October 31, 2023, the Public Sector Compensation Transparency Act was referred to the Standing Committee on Families and Communities pursuant to Government Motion 7. In accordance with section 14 of the act the committee must submit its report to the Assembly within six months after beginning its review, and that report is to include any amendments recommended by the committee.
