Guide to the 2012-2014 Speaker Index

Committee mandate: The Standing Committee on the Alberta Heritage Savings Trust Fund is an all-party committee consisting of nine Members of the Legislative Assembly. It annually reviews and approves the fund's performance, business plan, and annual report; receives and reviews the quarterly reports on the fund's operations and results; holds public meetings with Albertans to report on investment activities and results; and reports to the Legislature on whether the mission of the fund is being fulfilled.

There are two indexes for the transcripts of meetings of the Standing Committee on the Alberta Heritage Savings Trust Fund, a subject index and a speaker index. These indexes cover committee activities during the 28th Legislature, First Session (May 23, 2012– March 2, 2014).
