### hGuide to the 2015-2016 Speaker Index

**Committee mandate:** Standing Committee on Legislative Offices is an all-party committee consisting of 11 Members of the Legislative Assembly. The committee approves the budgets of the Officers of the Legislature, including the Auditor General, the Child and Youth Advocate, the Chief Electoral Officer, the Ethics Commissioner, the Information and Privacy Commissioner, the Ombudsman, and the Public Interest Commissioner, and also reviews the salaries of the officers on an annual basis. The committee can entertain officers' requests regarding proposed changes to legislation and forward the recommendation to the appropriate ministry. However, the committee does not have the mandate to approve changes to legislation.

There are two indexes for the transcripts of meetings of the Special Standing Committee on Legislative Offices, a **subject index** and a **speaker index**. This index is unedited and is for reference purpose only. It is not an official document. Committee activity during the 29th Legislature, First Session (June 15, 2015 – March 7, 2016) is as follows.
