

## Guide to the 2022 (Third Session) Subject Index

**Committee mandate:** The Standing Committee on Legislative Offices approves the budgets of the Officers of the Legislature, including the Auditor General, the Chief Electoral Officer, the Child and Youth Advocate, the Ethics Commissioner, the Information and Privacy Commissioner, the Ombudsman, and the Public Interest Commissioner, and reviews the salaries of the officers on an annual basis. The committee reviews officers' requests regarding proposed changes to legislation and forwards the recommendation to the appropriate ministry; the committee does not have the mandate to approve changes to legislation.

**Regulation review:** With the passage of Government Motion 30 on May 25, 2022, the Assembly referred consideration of a draft amendment to section 8 of the Publication Ban (Court Applications and Orders) Regulation, in accordance with section 131.1 of the Child, Youth and Family Enhancement Act, to the Standing Committee on Legislative Offices. The Committee must submit its report to the Assembly within three months of the day on which it commences its consideration of the draft regulation.

There are two indexes for the transcripts of meetings of the Standing Committee on Legislative Offices, a **subject index** and a **speaker index**. Interim indexes are unedited and are not considered official. Committee activities during the 30th Legislature, Third Session (February 22 – October 30, 2022) are as follows.
