

Guide to the 2020-2022 Subject Index

Committee mandate: The Standing Committee on Private Bills and Private Members' Public Bills reviews all petitions for private bills, hears from petitioners and any other persons interested in the private bill, and reports to the Assembly on its review. For more information on private bills please refer to the [Legislative Assembly of Alberta website page on private bills](#).

In addition, private members' public bills stand automatically referred to the committee in accordance with the standing orders. The committee must report back to the Assembly concerning its recommendations on whether the bill should or should not proceed to second reading debate within eight sitting days of the bill's referral.

There are two indexes for the transcripts of meetings of the Standing Committee on Private Bills and Private Members' Public Bills, a **subject index** and a **speaker index**. Interim indexes are unedited and are not considered official. Committee activities during the 30th Legislature, Second Session (February 25, 2020 – February 21, 2022) are as follows.
