

## Guide to the 2020 Subject Index

**Committee mandate:** The Select Special Public Health Act Review Committee was appointed to review the Public Health Act, and it may limit its review to sections of the act that it selects for consideration. The committee must submit its report to the Assembly, including any recommendations for amendments to the act, within four months after commencing its review.

There are two indexes for the transcripts of meetings of the Select Special Public Health Act Review Committee, a **subject index** and a **speaker index**. Interim indexes are unedited and are not considered official. Committee activities during the 30th Legislature, Second Session (February 25, 2020 – ) are as follows.
